Activity fee includes the Thanksgiving Feast, prayer partner activities, special holiday events, and Scholastic News. The school supplies include a variety of art supplies, paints, construction paper, nap-sacks, and science experiments. On occasion, a note will be sent home for a specific item that may need to be replenished. The pocket folder needs to have two pockets to transport important papers and the lunch calendar. (Some parents buy two folders and save one for the second half of the year because usually by February, the pocket folder has ripped.) The backpack needs to have your child's name in it and large enough to place the folder in it and zipper without bending the folder. Please supply an inexpensive rosary with an inexpensive case; also mark your child's name on the case. We will begin to learn about the rosary during class time.
