

Catholic Trivia ANSWER: B - St. Thomas More was born in London in 1478. His father was a lawyer and judge and Thomas and studied and became a lawyer in 1502. He also lived at a monastery for several years and was a very faithful man. He and his first wife had 4 children and Thomas insisted that his daughters receive the same education as his sons. He was a gifted theologian and writer and had a reputation for being effective and honest. He rose in the ranks of politics and was a trusted advisor to King Henry VIII, but their relationship became strained when Thomas refused to send a letter to the Pope to help the King obtain an annulment from his wife Catherine to marry Anne Boylen. Charges of treason were falsely made and Thomas was found guilty by a jury that included Anne Boylen's father, brother and uncle. This resulted in his death in 1535. Thomas More was canonized by Pope Pius XI 400 years later in 1935 and is the Patron Saint of lawyers, civil servants, politicians and difficult marriages.
